### **Class Supplies Check**

- Employability standards will be discussed in class, including being responsible and prepared to learn and work in class on a daily basis.
- First complete materials check for an “employability skills” grade will be Friday, August 31<sup>st</sup>. This is a graded assignment; missing supplies will result in a lower grade.
- Please see Mrs. N **before** August 31<sup>st</sup> if you have specific questions or are having difficulty acquiring any **required** items.

### **Required Items**

- \$20 class fee paid to Mrs. N or to office by August 31<sup>st</sup> (covers Future Problem Solving curriculum/fees & class projects)
- KMS planner with name written in permanent ink (provided by school)
- 3-ring binder (1” or larger) OR large section/dividers in larger zip-close binder
- 5+ index dividers with tabs (manila paper or plastic, with or without pockets)
- loose-leaf lined notebook paper (20-40 sheets to start with)
- composition notebook (100 pages, college-ruled, marbled or other cover)
- pencils (with erasers, extra lead)
- ink pens (dark blue/black ink, plus other colors for editing and correcting papers)
- highlighters (at least 2 different colors)
- 10 blank envelopes & 10 “forever” postage stamps (for mailing personal letters)

### **Recommended Items**

- one box of Kleenex-brand tissues
- zipper pouch for small class supplies
- sticky notes (for reading and research)
- USB flash drive (1 GB or larger)
- access to PC w/ MS Word & Internet
- school g-mail/personal e-mail account
- college dictionary & thesaurus (Merriam-Webster also available online)
- art supplies (colored pencils, gel pens, Sharpies, small scissors, markers, glue stick, etc.)
- letter writing supplies (notecards, stationery, envelopes, stickers, etc.)
