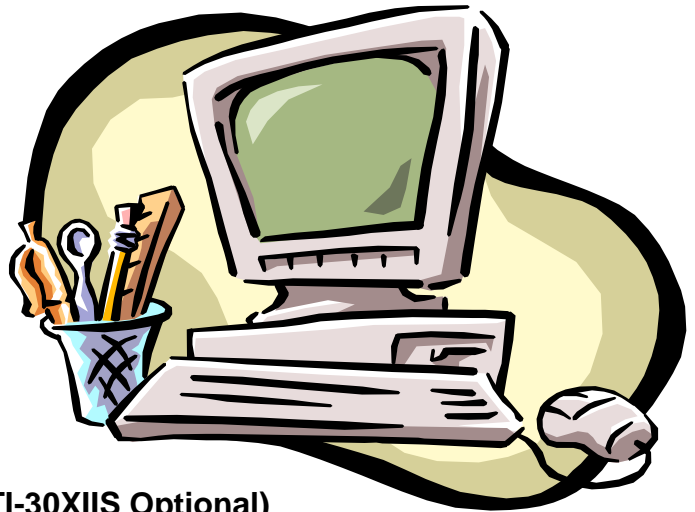

CONSEQUENCES

If class policies are not followed, we will be firm, fair, and consistent. The following are guidelines for handling classroom problems.

1. First Interaction - An oral warning and/or using time out areas in own room. If the offense is confrontational, the student may be sent to a prearranged time out room. Any problems that come up in the time out room will result in the second interaction.
2. Second Interaction - For the second offense we will follow the same action as for the first interaction plus the parent may be notified. The student's name may be given to the Assistant Principal informing him/her that the student has had two interactions. Student may lose the privilege of participating on field trips.
3. Severe Clause - The student may be sent directly to the office. The office will take whatever action they deem necessary to bring about a change in the negative behavior. A detention can be enacted immediately by the teacher or by the office.
4. We will be enforcing the school handbook policies at all time.
