### **The basic list of supplies for ORIGINS OF DEMOCRACY, 8<sup>th</sup> grade with MR. SUMMER will be:**

1. Spiral Notebook 100-120 pages just for this class. (Please no “neatbooks” as they come apart around January or February, depending on how jammed the locker is).
2. Pens and Pencils – blue or black please
3. Colored Pencils - for map work, etc.
4. Hi-lighter marker

\*\*A 3-ring binder to organize all classes will be very helpful.

### **The basic list of supplies for SCIENCE, 8<sup>th</sup> grade with MS. STOTZ will be:**

1. Folder & comp notebook
2. Pens, Pencils, and colored pencils
3. Hi-lighter marker
4. Four function calculator

### **The basic list of supplies for LANGUAGE ARTS, 8<sup>th</sup> grade with MRS. MIRANDA or MRS. TRUE will be:**

1. Composition Notebook (**not** a spiral bound)
2. Folder
3. Pens and Pencils with erasers
4. Colored pencils
5. Hi-Lighter marker

### **The basic list of supplies for 8<sup>TH</sup> GRADE MATH 3 with MRS. RININGER OR MRS. TRUE & ALGEBRA will be:**

1. Spiral Notebook 100-120 pages just for this class
2. 1.5 – 2 inch binder just for this class
3. Folder which fits in the binder
4. Pencils
5. Ruler with metric & standard measurement

\*\*OPTIONAL: scientific calculator

\*\*1” 3-ring Binder, and scientific calculator are MANDATORY for Algebra w/FISCHER
